THREE GREAT CONTEST IN OCTOBER

Saturday, October 5th, will be the annual Bowie Chicken and Bread Days Fiddle Contest. This will be the 30th year for this award and it is provided by the family of J Box Roberts and given to the favorite fiddler of the day. A very special thanks to Jesses Roy Hart, Mary Ann Norris, and all of those who help them with this contest.

Finally, on Saturday, October 19th, please make your way to downtown Gilmer for their 76th Annual East Texas Yamboree. Registration will open at 10:30 A.M. at the bandstand and the contest will begin at 1 P.M. This is also one of the longest running, and historic, contests in our great state. All of the greats have played at this contest through the years and was run for many years by the great Pee Wee Walker. Since his passing several years ago, his son, Charlie, has followed in his father's footsteps and has been a huge help in keeping this great contest going year after year.
