TOTFA Meeting Minutes – 01/18/2014

★ Old Business

- T-Shirt Sales
 - Permission obtained to use silhouette design by Jackie Williams.
 - Need to have T-shirts printed and sold.
- TOTFA stamp has been purchased.
- Fundraiser tentative date March 15, 2014.
 - Cook & Sell Food
 - Potato Salad, beans, brisket, baked onions, cookies, and brownines.
 - Rent port-a-potty.
 - Decide pricing.

★ New Business

- Membership – Bubba has been and will continue to maintain.
- Marketing Packets – printouts and online.
 - Contest Options
 - 4 contest size (fund based)
 - Could be mailed to organizers of events, such as Ft. Worth Stock Show, etc.
 - Fact list about TOTFA
 - Define contest organizer responsibilities
 - DVD or links on YouTube, for marketing
- Contest Packets – Tools to share with parties interested
 - Letter of intent for the organizer, “soft contract”
 - Ask for deposit and cancellation schedule
 - TOTFA budget – worksheet for expenditure/income tracking
 - TOTFA prize schedule – worksheet to manage distribution of funds
 - Announcer guide
 - Order of events
 - Sponsor list
 - List of judges
 - Pronunciation for anmes
 - Sponsors, with perhaps sponsorship levels. Such as, gold, silver, and bronze
 - Membership forms
 - Checklists
 - Score sheets
 - Tax exemption donation forms 100% tax deductible
 - Contest Schedule
 - Volunteers

Meeting Minutes – cont..

- Contests
 - One director responsible for each contest
 - Pay judges to book them in advance and have good judges. Judges perform.
 - Start contest with 30 minutes of entertainment. Stick to the schedule. Good MCs. Entertain during lunch to keep people from leaving and not coming back.
 - Provide post contest report. Pres. to review.
 - Record number of fiddlers, age ranges, audience size, length of event, etc. Use for marketing and promotion of future events. Must sell idea of contests to organizers.
 - President can make contact with organizer and thank them afterward
 - Setup reminder or that organizer for a later time and another contest.
 - Consider business cards with each director's name and phone number to promote TOTFA.
 - Consider TOTFA director name badges to ID directors
- Board Member responsibilities/titles
 - TOTFA Checkbook and finances
 - All directors title of director (Jordan – Treasurer)
 - Chase Signers (Bart, Jordan, John & Bubba)
 - TOTFA's 501 (c)(3) Status and federal tax reporting
 - File the annual report to keep our tax-exempt status. Form 802
- ★ Other Business
 - Reviewed potential contests
 - March 22, entertainment needed in Princeton. Bart would like to pay a few musicians to do this, and get paid to raise funds for TOTFA.
 - Music teachers and area. Provide this as a service to TOTFA members. TOTFA does not endorse any particular teacher. If you are a TOTFA member and would like to have your name added to this list, send your contact information to zirl.hopkins@gmail.com
 - Grants. We need someone to start working on grant money from the state of Texas. (John C.)
 - Texas folk life resources
 - Charter & official forms are needed to get these
 - Professional grant writers could be hired. Take 10% of grant.
 - Diversity is a factor
 - Texas Music Office, Texas Music grant Applicationg
 - Other fund raiser ideas
 - Tribute CD of present day champions and past & legendary champions
 - PA System for TOTFA for use at fundraisers and contests if needed. This might be a purchase goal for fundraiser.
