His prowess as a fiddler, musician, teacher and ambassador of Texas Fiddling commands the respect and admiration of all devotees and enthusiasts of Texas Fiddling everywhere. He is directly responsible for the taking Texas Fiddling far beyond the borders of Texas and was a pioneer in instructional videos and sharing of knowledge about Texas Fiddling making it the primary contest style of fiddling in the U.S.

By-Law Changes for Convention

The Board of TOTFA is reinstating the TOTFA Scholarship that was established several years ago but became dormant. In keeping with the 501 (c)(3) status of TOTFA, the Board of Directors would like to amend the bylaws to re-instate the TOTFA scholarship fund. We have redesigned the scholarship guidelines and criteria and those documents will be published at the Convention this year. The Board will be asking membership to approve these changes to the Bylaws:

Article II AMENDED shall read:

The purpose of the Texas Old Time Fiddlers Association shall be to promote Texas fiddling, improve Texas fiddling contests, sponsor an annual convention and contest, *maintain a scholarship fund*, and publish a monthly newsletter for benefit of the members.

Article VI RENAME as Article VII

Article VII RENAME as Article VIII

Article VIII RENAME as Article IX

Article IX RENAME as Article X

Article VI NEW shall read:

The Texas Old Time Fiddlers Association shall maintain a discretionary Scholarship Fund. The TOTFA Scholarship fund will be comprised of money donated specifically to the Scholarship Fund by members of TOTFA (either as cash donations or through fund raising) or money donated from the general funds of the TOTFA by the Board of Directors. The Scholarship Fund will be controlled separately from the general funds of TOTFA but will be controlled by the President and Board of Directors, who will keep the membership apprised of the amount of money in the Scholarship Fund via the Texas Fiddler. A document outlining the Rules and Eligibility, Selection Process, and General Information will be maintained by the Texas Old Time Fiddlers Association.

There will be a silent auction Saturday, November 14 & Sunday, November 15. All are encouraged to bring items to donate and their checkbooks to purchase. The proceeds will go to TOTFA and are tax-deductible for the market value of the item.
